

TAP CONNECTORS Installation Instructions




INSTALLATION MUST FOLLOW THE PROPER METHODS FOR ALL OF THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES:

- Wire preparation
 Size Combinations
 Crimp Locations
 Crimp Sequence/order
 Crimp Direction
- INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:
- 1. Select a connector from the info chart based on wire sizes, material, and construction.
- 2. If conductor is not bare, strip the wire insulation to the length shown in the info chart.
- 3. Remove oxides by using a wire brush on the bare conductor.
- 4. Place the correct die set into the tool according to the info chart.
- Insert conductor wires into the C-Tap and place the entire assembly into the tool head. (Open end of tap should face up or out of the open tool head. See Fig. 1)
