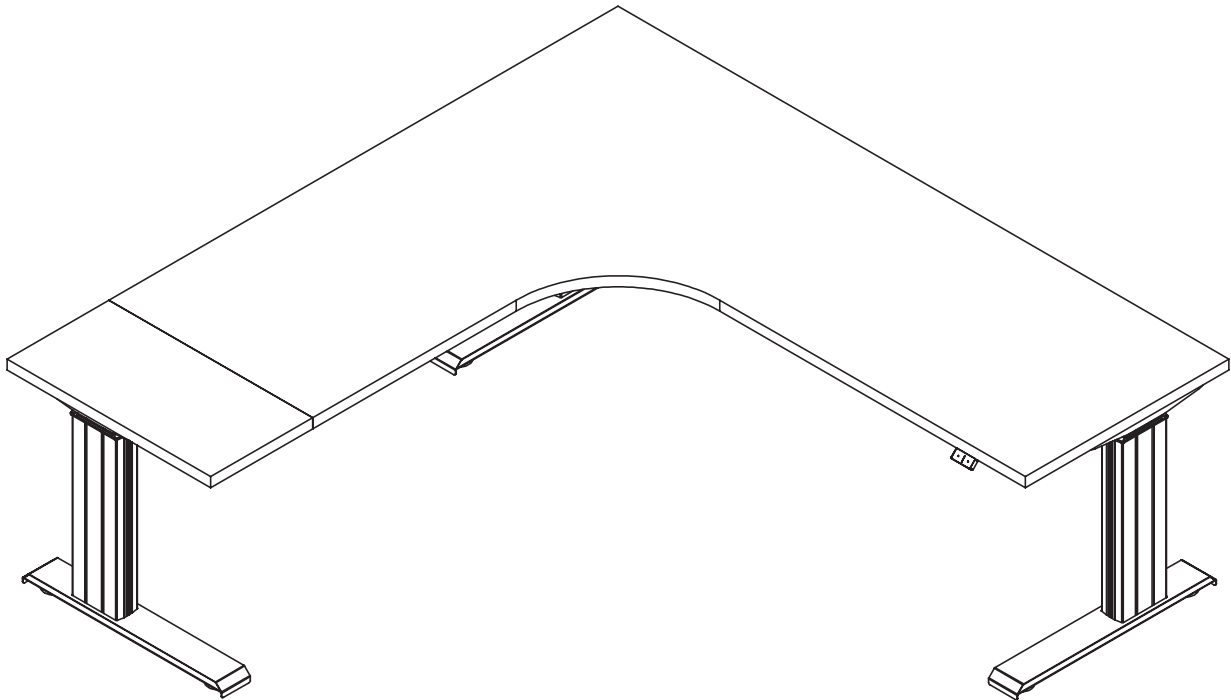

Make sure no obstacles are in the desk's path and all cords are of appropriate length for the desk. Always maintain a 1" clearance around the table to prevent pinching.

Never assemble (or disassemble) the table or components with the table plugged into a power outlet. This product is for use on a nominal 120-volt circuit and has a grounding plug. Make sure that the product is connected to an outlet having the same configuration as the plug. No adapter should be used with this product.

Duty Cycle: 2 minutes ON / 18 minutes OFF

Workstation can continuously operate for a maximum duration of two minutes. After two minutes of non-stop operation, the workstation will automatically stop and require eighteen minutes of cool down.

- L. Wire Management (size varies) x2
- M1. Two Button Up/Down Switch x1

- O. Power Cord x1
- P. Power Strip x1

Step 1

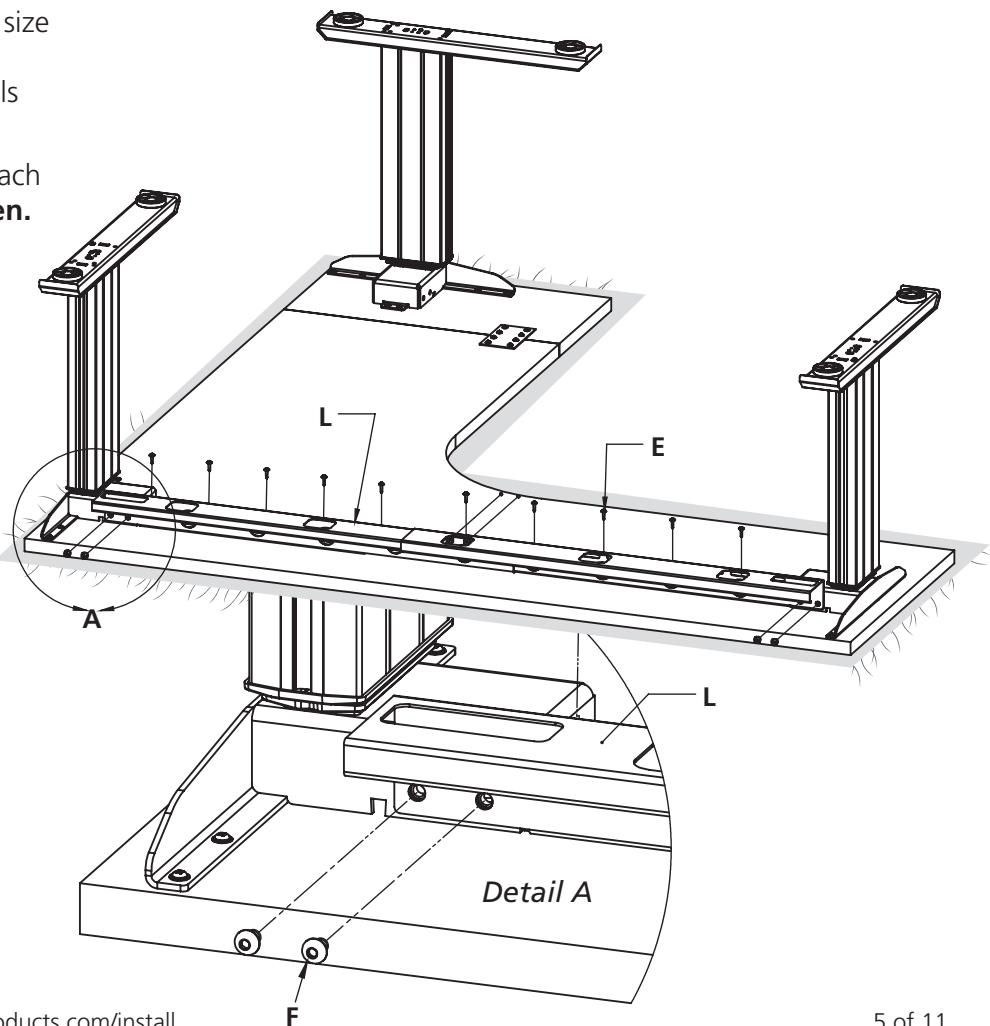
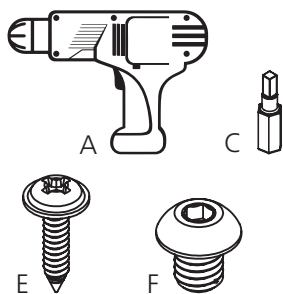
- Lay the worksurface on a protected surface with the pilot holes facing up. If your worksurface has a seam, lay the joiner plate centered on the seam about 3" from the front.
- Attach worksurface with eight wood screws.
- Pilot holes are not provided, screws are self drilling.
- Set the legs on the worksurface, align the legs over the pilot holes.
- Attach the legs onto the worksurface with six wood screws. **Do not tighten.**



NOTE: Depending on size of worksurface may or may not have a seam.

Step 2

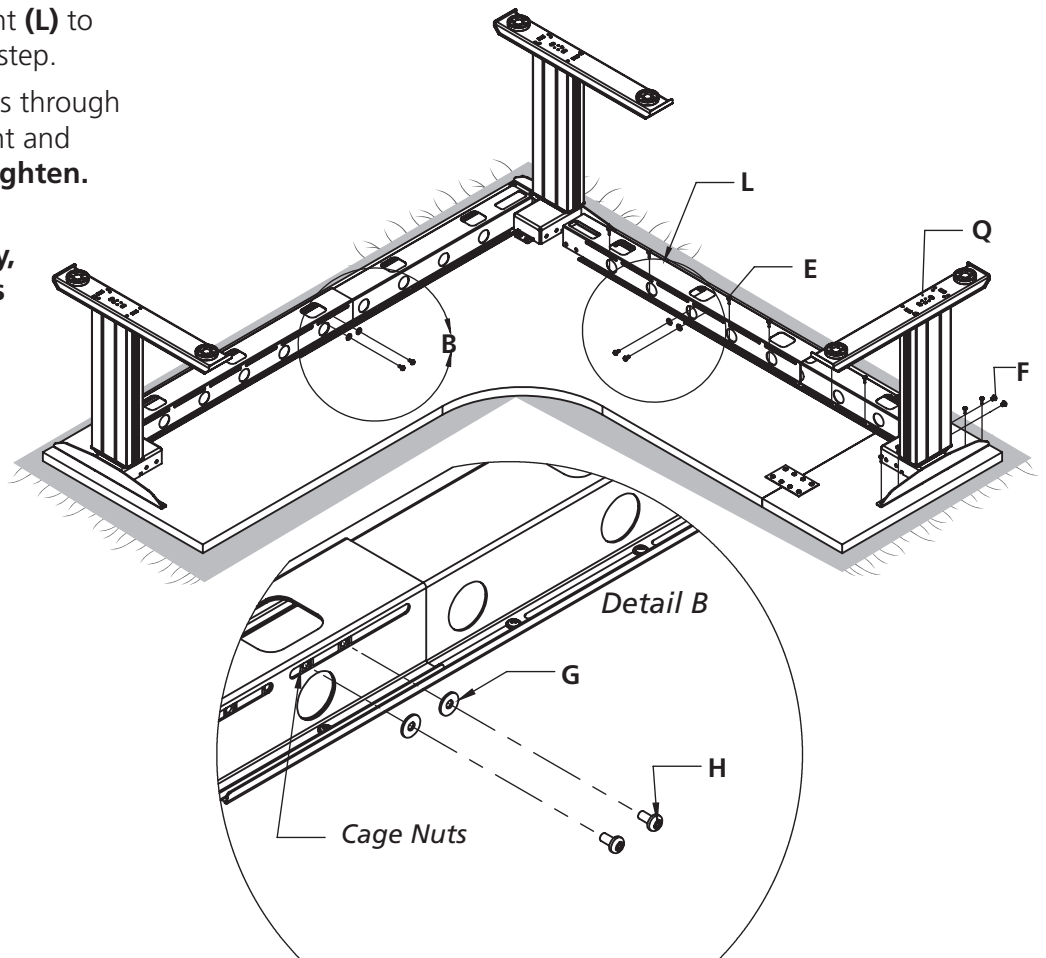
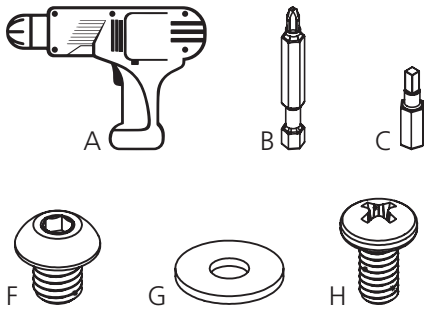
- Your workstation may have two different size wire management. Determine the correct location of the wire management channels according to the size of the worksurface.
- Slide apart the wire management and attach with four machine screws. **Do not tighten.**
- Install wood screws through the wire management and into the worksurface. Pilot holes are not provided, the screws are self drilling. **Do not tighten.**



Step 3

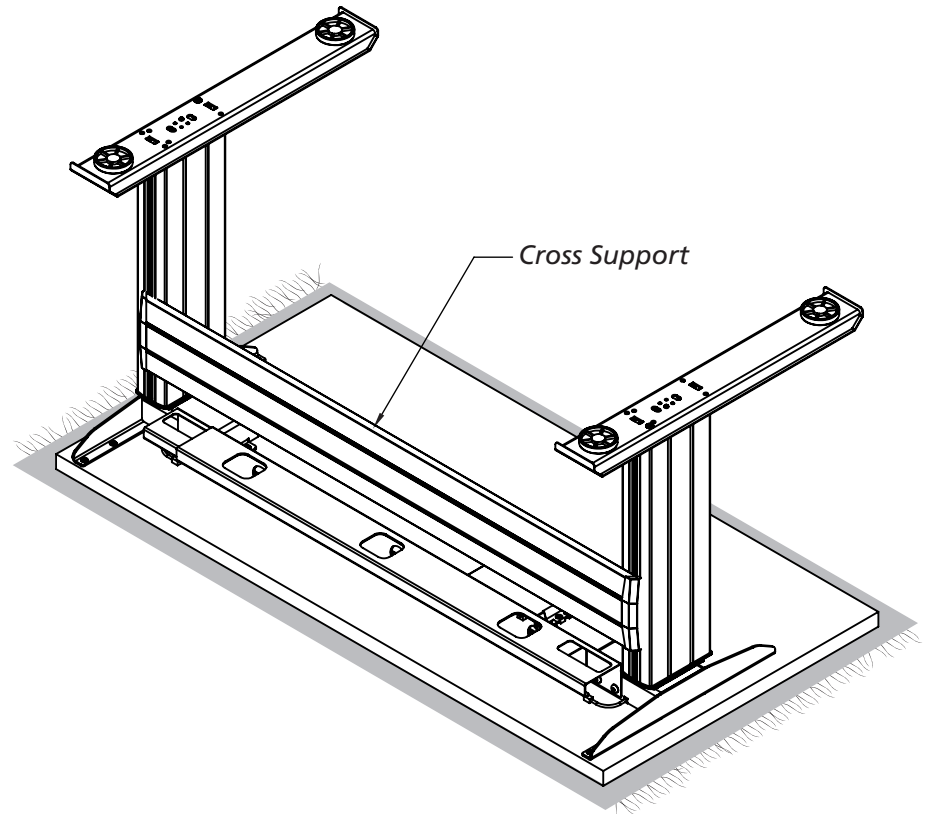
- Attach the other wire management (**L**) to leg (**Q**) same way as the previous step.
- Insert machine screws and washers through the slots of both wire management and into any two cage nuts. **Do not tighten.**

Note: If your table comes with cross supports for added stability, please refer to those instructions for the next step.



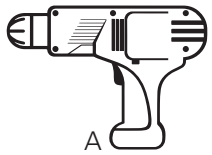
Step 4

- If your table comes with cross supports for added stability, please **refer to those instructions for this step.**
- If your table does not come with cross supports, continue to Step 5.



Step 5

- Fully tighten all screws and bolts.
- Install the switch, cable clamps, power strip, and control box. Pilot holes are provided only for the control box and switch.

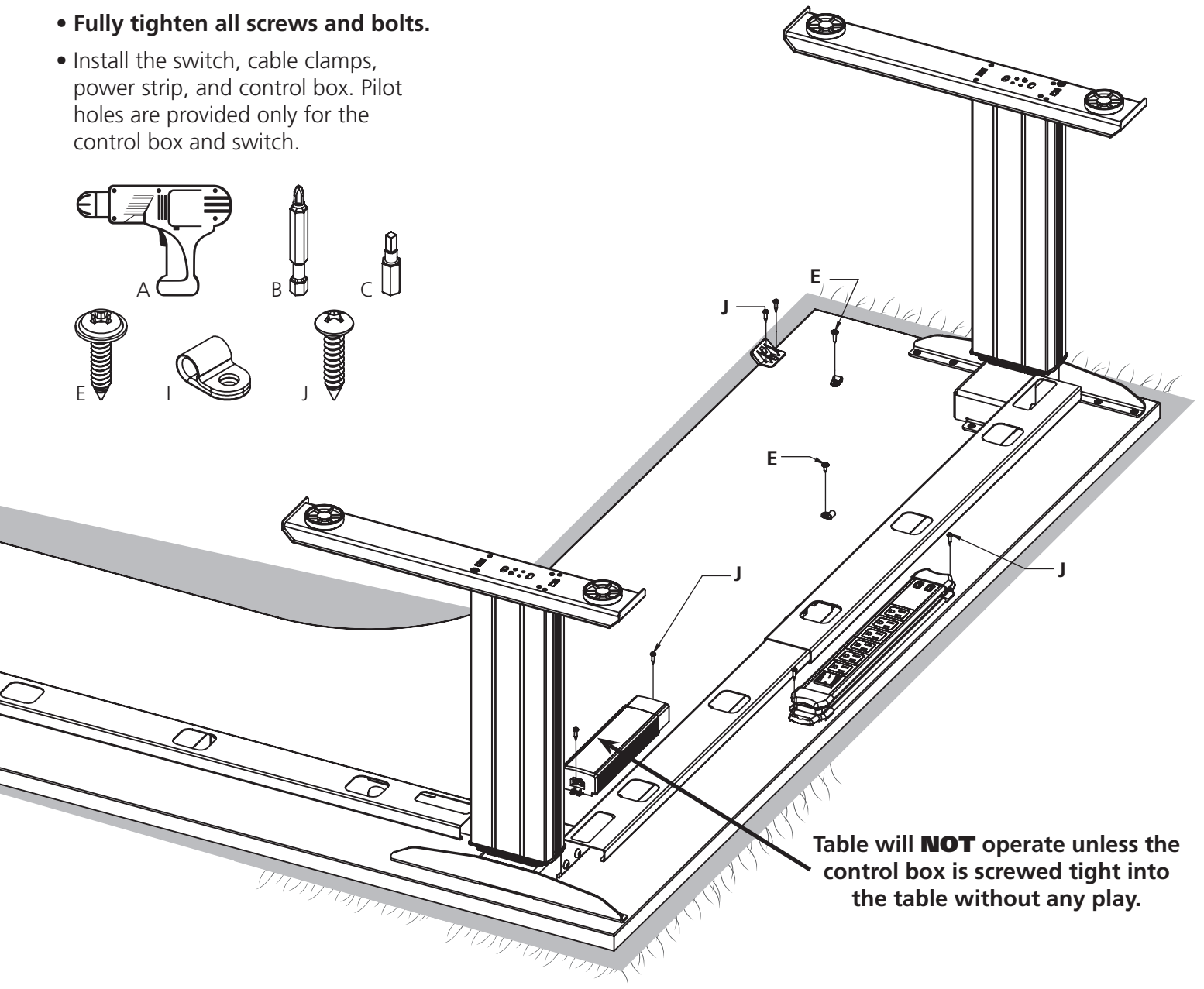
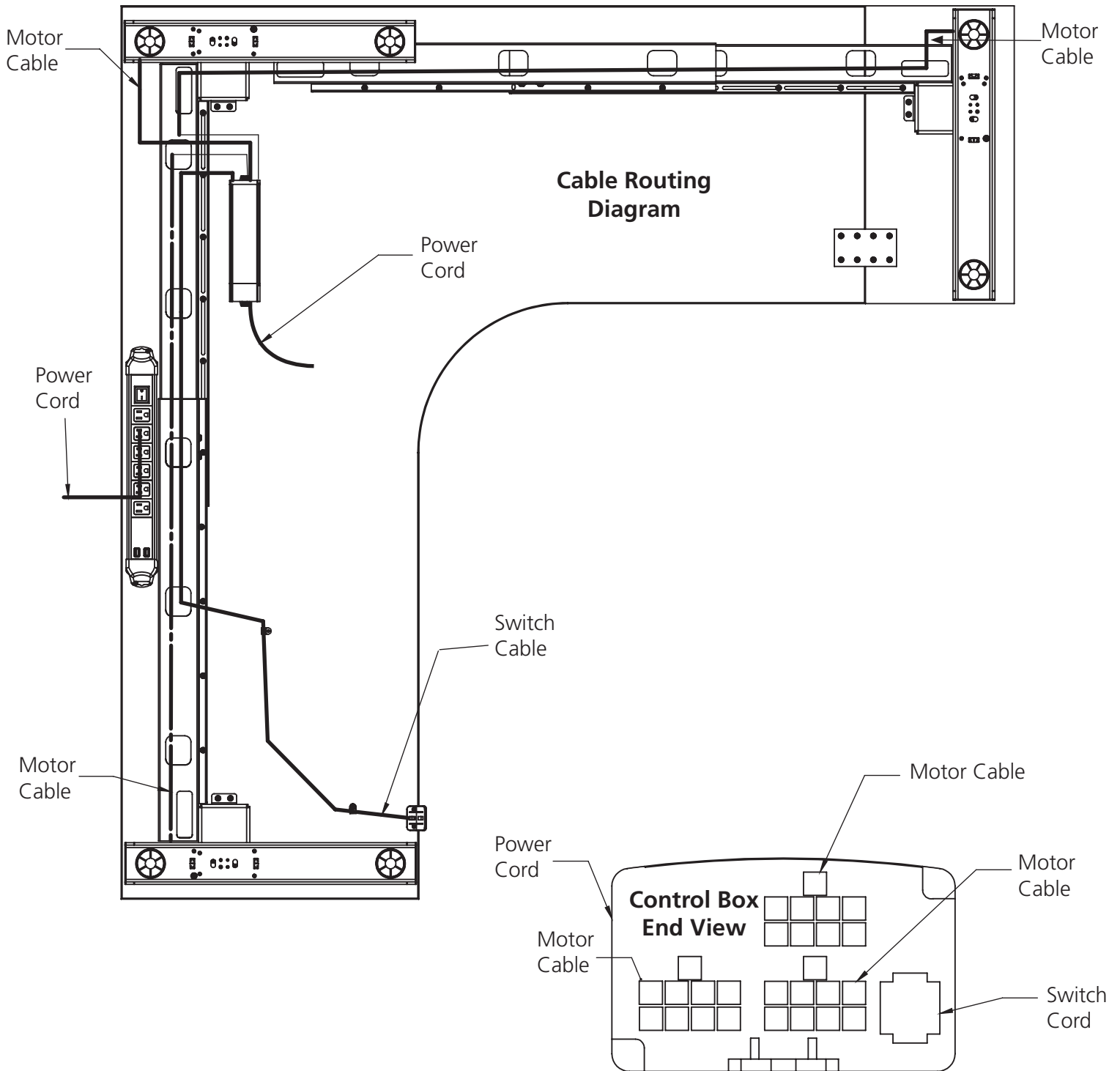


Table will **NOT** operate unless the control box is screwed tight into the table without any play.

Step 6

- Run all cables as shown on the diagram.



Caution:

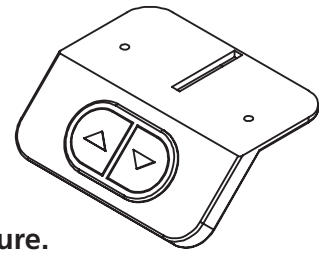


For the safety of the user and the workstation; the control box contains an internal sensor that is sensitive to movement, vibration, and collision. For faultless operation, ensure all cables, electronics, and accessories are cable managed and secured. Excessive load or weight must be distributed evenly. Failure to follow these guidelines may cause intermittent functionality.

Standard Switch Save for Reference

Start Up Procedure:













- Plug the power cord into a standard 110V receptacle. A power surge protector is recommended.
 - Press the down arrow until the worksurface reaches its lowest position.
 - The workstation is ready for use.
 - **If the table is not functioning normally or has lost power, perform the reset procedure.**

Reset Procedure:

- Unplug the unit from the wall for 10 seconds.
 - Clear all obstructions from the travel path of the desk.
 - Plug the unit back in the wall.
 - Press and hold the down arrow key until the table reaches its lowest position.

Add Container Stops:

- Move the table  to the upper or lower desired height.
 - Rapidly press  4 times. You will hear a musical tone. 
 - Rapidly press  2 times. A musical tone plays two times.  
 - To **add** the **upper** container stop press  A musical tone plays two times.  
 - To **add** the **lower** container stop press  A musical tone plays two times.

Remove Container Stops:

- Move the table  to the upper or lower **preset** height.
 - Rapidly press  4 times. You will hear a musical tone. 
 - Rapidly press  2 times. A musical tone plays two times.  
 - To **delete** the **upper** container stop press  You will hear a musical tone. 
 - To **delete** the **lower** container stop press  You will hear a musical tone. 
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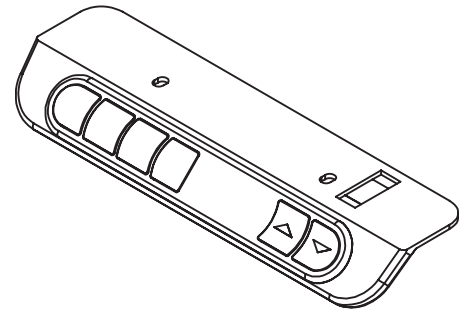

Optional Programmable Switch (full instructions packaged with switch)

Start Up Procedure:

- Plug the power cord into a standard 110V receptacle. A power surge protector is recommended.
- Press the down arrow until the worksurface reaches its lowest position.
- The workstation is ready for use.
- **If the table is not functioning normally, or has lost power, perform the reset procedure.**



Reset Procedure:

- Unplug the unit from the wall for 10 seconds.
- Clear all obstructions from the travel path of the desk.
- Plug the unit back in the wall.
- Press and hold the down arrow key until the table reaches its lowest position

Mechanical Reset Mode

If the table is unresponsive, uneven, or not functioning properly, perform a manual reset.










User settings are not reset in this process.

There are three methods to reset a workstation:

Reset Method A















1. Clear all obstructions from the travel path of the workstation
2. Disconnect the power to the control box for 30 seconds.
3. Reconnect the power
4. Press and hold the  until the workstation has reached its lowest possible position.

Reset Method B (4 button programmable switch required)

1. Clear all obstructions from the travel path of the workstation
2. Quickly press  +  +  +  to enter the menu mode.
3. P01 is displayed and you will hear a musical tone 
4. Press the   to navigate the menu.
5. Navigate to the P09 display
6. Press the  button to enter or accept
7. Press and hold the  until the workstation has reached its lowest possible position.

The workstation is now ready to operate

Reset Method C - 2 Button Switch

1. Clear all obstructions from the travel path of the workstation
2. Quickly press  +  +  +  to enter the menu mode.
3. You will hear a musical tone. 
4. Press  +  +  + 
5. You will reach the limit adjustment menu and hear four musical tones.    
6. Press and hold the  until the workstation has reached its lowest possible position.

The reference is re-calibrated, the table should be leveled and the height indication should be correct.
