Sample the Stain Before You Buy

Proper sampling is where it starts. This is critical because the same stain can look very different on various species of wood. Different prep and application methods also affect the final result. Therefore, sampling is the only way to make sure you get the color you want the first time.

Sampling is easy: on a small, inconspicuous test area (we recommend a minimum 2 sq. ft. space), simply do each step the way you will on all your siding and trim.

- Prep the wood.
- Apply the stain.
- Let the stain dry (both between coats and after all coats have been applied).

- If working with a contractor, don't allow the contractor to stain until you have thoroughly discussed and demonstrated the look you want. Show them the sample.
- Verify the look before all the wood is stained. It's always best if you can be onsite during the staining process.

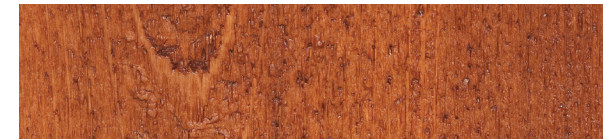

Available Colors

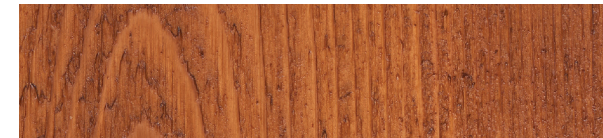

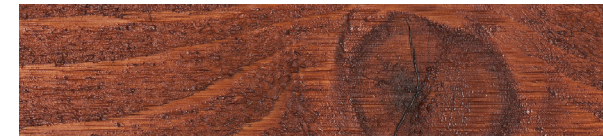

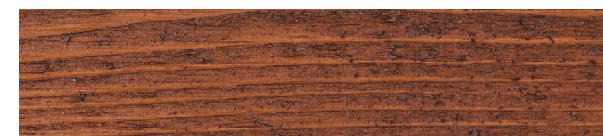
